

Rules and Requisitions VRCAS Airfield

- 1- All pilots must abide by the current safety rules and regulations of MAAC, the Vernon Remote Control Aermodelers Society (VRCAS) and Transport Canada pertaining to the use and operation of radio controlled model aircraft.
- 2- Pyrotechnics are not allowed on the premises.
- 3- All engines run ups should be inside of the designated pit area unless prior authorization has been given by the safety officer.
- 4- All spectators must remain behind the safety line (fence) unless escorted by a club member.
- 5- No alcoholic drinks or drugs are allowed on the property. Alcohol will only be allowed for campers in as assigned camping site within our designated camping area. No flying will be allowed under the influence of alcohol or drugs. VRCAS is a non smoking field.
- 6- Landing aircraft have unconditional right of way. Landing aircraft shall clear the runway as soon as possible.
- 7- Do not stand in the line of the prop arc of a running engine.
- 8- Announce takeoffs, landings and a dead stick so others may clear the way.
- 9- All aircraft pilots will stand in the designated area when flying at VRCAS.
- 10- All turns after takeoff are to be away from the pit or spectator areas, and no flying is to be done over the pit, or parking area.
- 11- No aircraft will be taxied in the pit area. Shutdown of engines is to occur at the taxiway entry.
- 12- Notify all pilots before walking on, crossing over and exiting the runway.
- 13- All pilots must have a spotter if more than one aircraft is in the circuit.
